



## Online & Remote Learning Information

At Ann Jerkins Harris Academy of Excellence (AJHAE), we are committed to providing students with consistent, high-quality learning opportunities whether instruction takes place in person, online, or through a blended learning model.

Our online and remote learning program is designed to support student achievement while maintaining compliance with all Ohio Department of Education and Workforce (ODEW) requirements

## Online & Remote Learning Options

Depending on school operations, weather conditions, emergencies, interventions, or instructional needs, AJHAE may provide:

- Remote learning days;
- Virtual instruction;
- Blended learning opportunities;
- Online intervention and tutoring;
- Digital learning assignments and enrichment.

Instructions may include both:

- **Live (synchronous) instruction** where students participate in real-time with teachers; and
- **Independent (asynchronous) learning** activities completed outside of live instruction.

## Student Expectations

Students participating in online or remote learning are expected to:

- Attend scheduled virtual sessions;
- Participate respectfully and appropriately;
- Complete assignments on time;
- Follow AJHAE's student code of conduct;
- Use school technology responsibly;
- Communicate with teachers when support is needed.

Students are expected to maintain appropriate behavior in all digital learning environments.

## **Parent & Guardian Partnership**

Parents and guardians play an important role in supporting student success.

Families are encouraged to:

- Monitor student attendance and participation;
- Ensure students are prepared for learning;
- Maintain communication with school staff;
- Support a positive learning environment at home when possible;
- Notify the school of technology or participation concerns.

## **Attendance & Participation**

Attendance and participation remain important during online or remote instruction.

Student participation may be documented through:

- Attendance during live sessions;
- Assignment completion;
- Participation in learning platforms;
- Communication with teachers;
- Completion of instructional activities.

Students who demonstrate limited participation may receive additional outreach and support from school staff.

## **Technology & Digital Learning**

AJHAE may provide devices, digital platforms, and instructional tools to support student learning.

Students and families are expected to:

- Use school-issued technology appropriately;
- Protect login information and devices;
- Report technical concerns promptly;
- Follow all acceptable use and digital citizenship expectations.

Improper use of school technology may result in disciplinary action or restricted access.

## **Student Privacy & Safety**

AJHAE is committed to protecting student privacy and confidentiality.

The school follows applicable federal and state laws regarding student records, technology safety, and digital learning platforms, including FERPA and student data privacy requirements.

Students and families should not record, distribute, or share classroom instruction or confidential information without permission.
